



- 6. संसार का उपकार करना इस समाज का मुख्य उद्देश्य है अर्थात् शारीरिक, आत्मिक और सामाजिक उन्नति करना ।
- 7. सबसे प्रीतिपूर्वक धर्मानुसार यथायोग्य वर्तना चाहिए |
- 8. अविद्या का नाश और विद्या की वृद्धि करनी चाहिए।
- 9. प्रत्येक को अपनी ही उन्नित से संतुष्ट न रहना चाहिए, किंतु सबकी उन्नित में अपनी उन्नित समझनी चाहिए।
- 10. सब मनुष्यों को सामाजिक सर्वहितकारी नियम पालने में परतंत्र रहना चाहिए और प्रत्येक हितकारी नियम में सब स्वतंत्र रहें।
